Complaints

If you have a concern about the operation of the grants panel and do not wish to complain, or do not know if it is something you should complain about, you could discuss your concern with the facilitator or anyone in our team.

Whistleblowing

Whistleblowing is the reporting of wrongdoing or dangers. This includes:

- criminal activity
- miscarriages of justice
- health and safety risks
- damage to the environment
- breaches of legal or professional standards
